### **Drama/Musical Camp: Six days. No Net, Youth Theatre Productions**

Youth ages 12-21 at start of camp.  
July 16-29, 2017(Sunday to the following Saturday)  
Check-in is between 4:00 and 5:00 PM  
Checkout will be approximately 10:00 AM

- One of the primary goals of this camp is to demonstrate the use of the theater arts as a ministry tool.
- Campers will be cast in either the drama or the musical. Drama is usually about 50 minutes in length and the musical is between 60-90 minutes. As an alternative, youth may also choose tech instead, if they wish to assist with lights, sound and sets.
- Maximum participants is 45
- Two local performances will take place July 21st and 22nd. Tour will run from July 23-29.
- In 2014 we presented 9 times in 8 days. In 2015, we presented 8 times in 7 days. 2016 8 in 8, It is anticipated that we will perform at Worlds of Fun in Kansas City this year.
- This years tour is scheduled to be in IA and NE, KS Final schedule will be posted on the camp website. Tour will also include educational/fun stops.
- NOTE: Although not likely, campers may stay in host homes while on tour.
- Cost includes all expenses except souvenirs and some personal snacks.
- Due to the length of the camp, we will attempt to do some laundry before we leave on tour, but try to bring a couple extra sets of clothes.
- STAFF: Staff will travel with the group and assist in various manners including chaperoning activities.
