Drama/Musical Camp: Six days, No Net, Youth Theatre Productions

Youth ages 11-21 at start of camp.
July 8-21, 2018 (Sunday to the following Saturday)
Checkout will be approximately 10:00 AM Saturday

- One of the primary goals of this camp is to demonstrate the use of the theater arts as a ministry tool.
- Campers will be cast in either the drama or the musical. Drama is usually about 50 minutes in length and the musical is between 60-90 minutes. As an alternative, youth may also choose tech instead, if they wish to assist with lights, sound and sets.
- Maximum participants is 45
- Two local performances will take place July 13th and 14th. Tour will run from July 15-21.
- We will perform 8-10 in 8 days.
- This years tour is likely to be in IA and NE, SD Final schedule will be posted on the camp website. Tour will also include educational/fun stops.
- NOTE: Although not likely, campers may stay in host homes while on tour.
- Cost includes all expenses except souvenirs and some personal snacks.
- Due to the length of the camp, we will attempt to do some laundry before we leave on tour, but try to bring a couple extra sets of clothes.
- STAFF: Staff will travel with the group and assist in various manners including chaperoning activities.



Fishing Camps:

Each fishing camp week will include specific time both fishing and learning fishing skills. Participants will also participate in many regular camper activities such as chapel, swimming, etc. Fishing equipment will be provided.
